Must be 1 MB or higher – any submissions lower than this benchmark will be rejected.

Photo and testimonial must address the experience of education and learning to portray what international education means to you, how studying in Canada or abroad has impacted/will impact your career prospects and/or future aspirations, and how it has/will help you achieve your goals. Photos must not have been previously published, submitted in other contests or won previous awards; and must not infringe on the rights of any third party. CBIE reserves the right not to consider any entry it deems to be inappropriate.

Judging: Winner(s) will be announced at CBIE's gala on Tuesday, November 15, 2016.
