Job Information

The beautiful and culturally progressive State of Qatar is home to the world class post-secondary institution, College of the North Atlantic-Qatar (CNA-Q). Internationally recognized as a comprehensive technical college, CNA-Q is committed to high quality, student-centered education. This commitment is reflected through state-of-the-art facilities, accessible and responsive technology programs and strong partnerships with industry.

The college in Qatar is owned by the State but as part of the Comprehensive Agreement, operates as College of the North Atlantic-Qatar. With more than 600 staff and 2,400 students, CNA-Q is one of Qatar's largest post-secondary institutions. By providing training in a range of technical areas including Engineering Technology, Health Sciences, Industrial Trades, Business Studies and Information Technology, CNA-Q brings the State closer to the goals of *Qatar National Vision 2030*.

DUTIES: The instructor will be responsible for the development, delivery and evaluation of a broad range of courses within the Telecommunications Technology technician and technologist Diploma program. S/he will evaluate student progress and manage the resources of the learning environment. The instructor will liaise with industry and other educational institutions; participate in industry advisory committees and coordinate, manage and control projects within the specified program area. Instructors will keep course portfolio documents required for accreditation processes and engage in instructional development/improvement plans. All employees are expected to contribute to professional and community life within the College and beyond.

The successful candidate possesses these qualifications and competencies:

Minimum of a Bachelor of Engineering (Electrical) with specialization in area of instruction, plus two years recent, relevant industry experience; or a Diploma in Telecommunications Engineering Technology, or other accredited Engineering Technology diploma in area of instruction, supplemented with a Bachelor of Technology or Bachelor of Engineering Technology and four years recent, relevant industry experience. A Bachelor of Education (Secondary or Post-Secondary) and eligibility for membership in an appropriate professional association would be assets. The successful candidate must have experience and knowledge related to wireless technologies, IP Telephony, networking technologies, switching, routing, and broadband networks. Instructor training and/or experience teaching at the post-secondary level are definite assets. Expertise in curriculum development is desirable. Candidates must demonstrate an understanding of how to effectively deliver course material (in classroom and laboratory environments), evaluate student progress, and support and mentor a diverse student population to ensure academic success. Exemplary communication and interpersonal skills and expert fluency in English are required. Effective problem solving skills and the ability to develop effective working relationships across all levels of the organization are also required. Candidates must possess strong computer skills and knowledge of learning technologies. A demonstrated commitment to working in a team and learner centered environment is also required. Intercultural competence including intercultural sensitivity and adaptability, and an ability to behave appropriately and effectively in another culture are essential. Knowledge of the CNA college system is a definite asset. Candidates with an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
