DUTIES: The Program Development Coordinator, under the direction of the Chair, Program Development, will provide leadership in program development initiatives and will provide technical and pedagogical expertise in the implementation of new and revised programs; Coordinate the program design, development and review of programs to be offered at CNA-Qatar ensuring they meet the strict quality guidelines of CNA; Coordinate the development and quality control of the learning resources and modules for delivery of current programs and new programs to be developed; Coordinate the development of modularized curriculum for the increased contract training offerings to industry clients; Manage the resources required for development in both regular and contract programs and ensure accuracy and quality of all development. Review all outgoing documentation and provide editing services as required. The Program Development Coordinator will also conduct needs assessments on new program initiatives that have been identified, facilitate the development of program proposals, course outlines and learning resource identification. The Program Development Coordinator will work with various teams, committees, and content experts to facilitate program development and provide expertise on various educational frameworks as it pertains to program design, development and review, as assigned.

The successful candidate possesses these qualifications and competencies:

A degree in Education and five years of relevant work experience is required. A Master's degree would be a definite asset. Experience in post-secondary education with an in-depth knowledge of the principles of program design, program/curriculum development, project management, adult learning, teaching and learning strategies and continuous improvement processes is essential. Demonstrated expertise in needs analysis, facilitation, and evaluation methods would be a definite asset, along with experience working in a TAFE environment. This position requires excellent organizational skills, independent thinking, the capacity to establish effective working relationships, and a strong commitment to working in a team and learner-centered environment. Excellent interpersonal, communication and presentation skills are essential along with technical writing and document production skills to ensure presentations and documentation meet high quality assurance standards. Intercultural competence including intercultural sensitivity and adaptability, and the ability to conduct oneself appropriately and effectively in another culture, are essential. Knowledge of the CNA college system and its programs will be considered an asset.
