### Photo Guidelines

- Must be 1 MB or higher – any submissions lower than this benchmark will be rejected.
- Testimonials must be in English or French.
- Photos and testimonials must address the experience of education and learning to portray what international education means to you, how learning abroad (studying and/or working) has impacted/will impact your career prospects and/or future aspirations, and how it has/will help you achieve your goals.
- Please, no leisure travel/vacation photos. Photos must not have been previously published, submitted in other contests or won previous awards; and must not infringe on the rights of any third party.
- The Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) reserves the right not to consider any entry it deems to be inappropriate.

### Judging

- Winners will be voted on and announced at CBIE's Annual Conference in Halifax, Nova Scotia in November.
