

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Consultancy Services for the Design, Delivery and Evaluation of Capacity Building Programs in the Philippines

Submission Deadline: Sunday, March 21, 2021, 5:00PM EST

CONTEXT

In anticipation of the finalization of an agreement to deliver a multi-faceted, capacity building program in the Philippines, CBIE is looking to gather short expressions of interests (EOIs) with cost estimates from interested CBIE member institutions for each the following three consultancy opportunities:

- (1) Adult and Continuing Education Training Program,
- (2) Innovative and Sustainable Development of HEIs Training Program, and
- (3) Community, Industry, Indigenous and International Partnerships Training Program.

Eligible applicants must be an active CBIE <u>member institution</u>.

Each training program, as detailed in the next section, involves a mix of long-distance, virtual/online learning, and in-person (in Canada and in the Philippines) delivery requirements as permitted within the anticipated relaxation of COVID-19 pandemic travel restrictions. Delivery requirements will be regularly assessed and closely monitored during the proposal development and implementation phases of the contract.

Implementation of the overall program will be managed by CBIE, and will involve close collaboration with a multitude of Canadian and international stakeholders.

The timeframe for the delivery of each consultancy opportunity is 16 months (anticipated completion date of the overall program is December 2022).

Based on the requirements of the beneficiary, the language of this consultancy will be English.

All consultancy opportunities are contingent upon the finalization of an agreement and contract with the project funder. Details described below regarding the timelines, details and scope of work descriptions, and objectives of the consultancy opportunities are subject to change based on a finalized agreement and contract with the project funder.

Once the agreement with the project funder is finalized, CBIE will be in contact with short-listed EOI candidates to provide updated details of the consultancy opportunities and to request more detailed proposals for consultancy services should the short-listed candidate continue to be interested in pursuing the opportunity.

EOI CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

Institutions must submit a separate EOI for each opportunity for which they would like to be considered.

EOIs should be no more than two-pages of narrative, in addition to the completed cost-estimate template. The following elements should be included:

- 1. Organizational Description: Description of your institution and relevance to the assignment
- 2. Relevant Experience: List of relevant training program design and development consultancies.
- 3. Contact: Contact information for lead consultant within your institution.
- 4. Cost Estimate: (see below for template) Cost Estimates must take into consideration:
 - Realistic and market relevant cost estimate for consultancy fees to design, implement and evaluate program. This can include either a lump sum institutional fee or daily rates for multiple individuals from the institutional team.
 - Realistic and market relevant cost estimate for reimbursable expenses (travel, accommodations, meals, room rentals, technology, materials) required to successfully implement program.

EOIs and cost estimates should be valid for a six-month time period from date of submission to CBIE.

The program will provide learners with the necessary skills and support for the successful development of their institutional adult education and training centre, and provide them with an understanding of adult education learning and development methodologies, with Canadian best practices as examples.
- 2. Facilitate three, in-country workshops that will provide additional support and training modules for 40 HEI representatives.
- 3. Conduct three, virtual learning workshops and discussions that will support the learning objectives of the 40 HEI representatives.
- 4. Provide long-distance support to the 40 HEI representatives over the course of the 12-month implementation period, including providing written feedback on their institutional strategic plans and an evaluation of the training program.
- 5. Participate at Final National Workshop to both present objectives and final results of the program.

OPPORTUNITY #2: INNOVATIVE AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF HEIS TRAINING PROGRAM

ULTIMATE OBJECTIVES

- Increase the ability of senior academic leaders in planning, integrating, and sustaining innovative development activities of the HEIs in order to meet the challenges of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)
- Increase the ability of senior academic leaders to design and implement business continuity and emergency preparedness plans, as a response to global and local events (i.e. COVID 19 pandemic, environmental disasters, health and food security)
- Increase the ability of HEI departments to integrate innovative actions towards the SDGs and long-term sustainability planning into all curriculum.
- Enhance the labour market relevance and responsiveness to emerging industries and trends of the HEIs in the Philippines through industry-academe linkages and collaboration.

CONSULTANCY ASSIGNMENT

- Design and implement a two-week, in-Canada professional certificate program for 80 senior administrators from HEI (40 college & 40 university, may necessitate multiple cohorts). The program will provide learners with the necessary skills and support for the successful development of their institutional long-term sustainability plans, with Canadian best practices as examples.
- 2. Facilitate three, in-country workshops that will provide additional support and training modules for 80 HEI representatives.
- 3. Conduct three, virtual learning workshops and discussions that will support the learning objectives of the 80 HEI representatives.
- 4. Provide long-distance support to the 80 HEI representatives over the course of the 12-month implementation period, including providing written feedback on their institutional strategic plans and an evaluation of the training program.
- 5. Conduct three, train-the-trainer workshops which aim to disseminate learning to the broader academic community and create an SDG Leadership Group.
- 6. Participate at Final National Workshop to both present objectives and final results of the program.

- 5. Participate at Final National Workshop to both present objectives and final results of the program.
