English Language Training Program For Libyan Government Officials Call for Expression of Interest June 2022

1. Background

As part of its work with governments and international organizations in developing opportunities to enhance the positioning of Canadian expertise in the field of international education, the Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) is currently providing logistical and strategic support to Libyan government agencies for the design and implementation of an English language training program for officials of selected Libyan agencies. This initiative reinforces the extensive collaborative work between CBIE and the Government of Libya through the Libyan-North American Scholarship Program (LNASP).

2. Key Deliverable

The Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) is looking for one (1) or two (2) partners among its members to design and implement two English language-training programs for Libyan officials in the following two categories.

The selected institution or institutions will be responsible for one or both of the following programs, from design to implementation, ensuring the highest quality and effectiveness that characterizes Canadian methods of teaching English to adults.

Program 1

Short-term English as a Foreign Language Training Program for Libyan Government Officials	
Duration	Six (6) months
Location	A third country, preferably: Turkey, Cyprus or Malta
# of Learners:	From 12-15 employees at intermediate to advanced language levels
Delivery	Libyan government officials will travel to the selected third country to receive English language training from a Canadian institution for six (6) months.
Notes	Canadian institutions with experience in English language training for Arabic-speaking adults and with the capacity to prepare courses abroad and/or with satellite institutions in Europe or the Middle East would be ideal candidates.

Program 2

Long-term English as a Foreign Language Training Program for Libyan Civil Servants	
Duration	One (1) year
Location	Canada
# of Learners:	From 3-5 employees at advanced language levels
Delivery	Senior Libyan officials will travel to Canada for a one-year stay dedicated to learning English as a foreign language.
Notes	All member institutions with EFL programs are invited to express interest.

3. Schedule and Timeline

The contract is expected to begin by the end of October 2022. Actual dates to be determined.

4. Budget

Details on the budget to be invested by the Libyan counterpart are yet to be determined. Interested institutions are asked to provide an estimated budget for the development of curriculum and delivery of the program.

5. Application Process

The Expression of Interest should include the following points:
