

Geometry:


 For the first level plan, the path of the bridge follows a controlled pattern which reminds us of the graph of the function y=cos(π*x/6).



 The highlighted sides in the 2nd level plan are similar to catenary curves, mimicking the freely hanging cable perfectly. The formula for the catenary curve is y=a*cosh(x/a)

<u>* The</u> 3rd level of the bridge contains two parts of the same mathematical curve named ellipse, which have been highlighted in a brighter shade of green. We know that the standard form for this shape is: $\frac{p_{e}t}{p_{e}^{2}} + \frac{p_{e}^{2}}{a_{e}^{2}} = 1$


JPOD (Joint Programming -Own Degrees)

- A program collaboration between 2 or more institutions where students from these institutions come together to form one cohort
- The program and the educational experience (objectives, content, curriculum) is jointly designed & delivered but the students from each institution get their own degrees from their institution




Master of Global Business (MGB)

- A graduate-level JPOD initiative among 3 universities
- The 3 universities are located on 3 continents (NA-Europe-Asia; NA-Europe-SA)
- 3 active tracks:
 - Canada (UVic)-Austria (JKU)-Taiwan (NSYSU)
 - Canada (UVic)-Austria (JKU)-Peru (Centrum)
 - Canada (UVic)-Scotland (Glas)-Thailand (Chula)
- Since 2008




